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Blue/Steady: Another competitor is close.

Blue/Waved: Another competitor is trying to pass

White: Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit

Yellow/Waved: Danger, no overtaking, slow down with full control of the vehicle.

Yellow/Double Waved: Great danger, no overtaking, slow down considerably, be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line or even stop. This signal may be supplemented or replaced by flashing yellow lights.

Yellow with Red Stripes: Slipperv surface ahead.

Green: Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.

Green/Waved: All clear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and shown at all posts during first lap of each practice session and during the formation lap.

Red: Stop racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals: (at startline and individual marshals posts).

Black/Orange Disc displayed with White number: Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver, call into pits immediately.

Black/White rectangular with White number: Warning to driver that his behaviour (i.e. corner cutting) is suspect and he may be black flagged.

Black display with White number: Driver must call in immediately and report to the clerk of the course.

Black/White Chequered: End of race.

Races are started using a system of Red traffic

OT COUPE CUP WITH TOYO TYRES







The OT Coupe Cup with Toyo Tires returned to racing at Cadwell Park last month after the winter period, and Mark Ridout picked up where he left off at the end of the 2023 season. Pole position, two race wins and one fastest lap was almost the perfect start to his season, taking the initial advantage over his rivals. 2023 Driver of the Year, Luca Staccini was always going to be on the pace, but could only manage two third places. The big surprise from Cadwell Park however was Dan Munro! In his first ever car racing weekend, Dan managed to line up second on the grid in the Cursley Motorsport Hire Car!

In Race One we saw plenty of action, which saw Mark Ridout and Luca Staccini having to work their way back through the field, after a spin for Paul Lawrie sent all three of them off track at Park corner. This left Munro comfortably in the lead ahead of Darren Banks and Michael Evans. Bold moves from Ridout and Staccini saw them climb through the pack, and a Safety Car period bunched the drivers up! Unfortunately, on the restart, Dan Munro's charge was halted as an electrical fault saw him plummet into retirement. This left Mark Ridout to wrestle the win from Darren Banks, who came second after holding Luca Staccini behind him!

In Race Two, Munro surged through the pack to claim his maiden podium, while Jake Silvester, Key Middleton, Paul Lawrie and Darren Swift all enjoyed a close battle in the mid pack. The Coupe Cup always delivers great racing, and Mallory Park this weekend will be no exception. This is the sixth time the Coupe Cup has raced at Mallory Park - could it be the best iteration yet? Luca Staccini will want to cement his season challenge with a win, while Dan Munro will be eager to notch up his first victory, but can they beat Mark Ridout?





SUPER CLASSIC PRE '99 FORMULA FORDS



Having completed its first two meetings of the 2024 season, the BRSCC's Super Classic Pre '99 Formula Ford Championship is ready to touch down for its third outing of the year, as the drivers move on to the rapid little speed bowl that is Mallory Park in Lincolnshire.

The Super Classic Pre '99 Formula Ford Championship provides a home for Kent-engined Formula Ford chassis built between 1967 and 1998, with competition across four classes split between different age ranges. In 2024, the championship visits some of the best suited and most popular circuits for Formula Ford racing including Brands Hatch, Silverstone, Donington Park, Oulton Park and indeed Mallory Park.

Each of the four classes are embroiled in their own battles as well as competing on track against one another, and it's not uncommon to find various ages of cars representing all four competing at the head of the field. Regardless of the age or make, a well-tuned Formula Ford chassis and engine coupled with a guick driver has every chance of being a front runner, no matter the class.

Super Classic A features the youngest cars on the grid built between 1990 and 1998. So far this season there's been class wins for Alex Ames at Silverstone and Richard Freye at Oulton Park, both sporting Van Diemens. Other strong competitors here should include the Swifts of Tom Hawkins and Paul Mason, along with the 1992 Mondiale chassis of Neil Hunt.

Super Classic B houses cars that featured a real boom period for Formula Ford during the 1980s, with cars built between 1982 and 1989 permitted. Two drivers that enjoyed some fine battles at Oulton Park were Chris Stones and Peter Daly, both fighting for position in each of the races in Cheshire. Those scraps look set to continue, and watch out for others on the grid including Lorna Vickers who currently sits second in the class standings.

Cars built between 1981 and 1972 can be found in Super Classic C, with many different chassis found here spanning another golden era of Formula Ford. So far in 2024, it's been all about Jake Shortland, a young racer learning his craft at the wheel of a Lola. Four class wins from four starts have been his achievement so far, and will be hard to beat if he's on the grid.

As for Super Classic D, for cars built before 1972, Oliver Buckton has been another stand-out driver and, like Shortland, has been able to take the fight to younger machinery at the wheel of his Elden. Watch for him to get amongst some of the front runners on more than one occasion, as he's set to do battle with Ian Fernihough and co in class.

The Ashstone MEP super saloons and tin tops have a good entry for Sunday. Hot on the heels of the Brands Hatch GP circuit races, which unfortunately ended with a big crash. The list of potential winners is headed by Adrian Bradley (BMW E46) who has been the guickest runner this year, but not had a very lucky start to his season. Conversely Paul Watson has been very consistent in his BMW E36 picking up an overall win at Castle Combe. Series stalwart Rod Birley may be missing as he came off worse in the multi car shunt at Brands Hatch. His BMW E36 was destroyed when it barrel rolled into a bridge. However, if he recovers in time, we may see him in another BMW.

There are more guick BMWs in the hands of Ronan Bradley, Mark Cripps, James Hunt, Jacques Whitehead and Dave Avis. Fortunately there is some variety in the shape of Ford Escorts for Martin Reynolds and Colin Claxton, whilst Danny Cassar could spring a surprise or two in his Honda Integra.

In the tin tops section, which caters for more standard cars using road tyres, expect to see Chris Bassett at the forefront. The Hondas of Matt Rowling and Neal Gardiner (who had a major shunt here last year) will not be far behind. The unusual Volvo C30 of Adrian Matthews has been slowly improving, whilst Sam Heywood is adapting well to turbo power in his Renault Megane. It will be interesting to see how many super saloons the tin tops manage to beat.

500 OWNERS ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP



The 500 Owners Association is the leading organisation for the preservation and promotion of 500cc F3 racing cars.

The club runs Championships for Circuit, Hillclimbs and Sprints at over 20 events each year for its 200 members and their 150+ cars.

The original 500 Club started in 1946 and after changing its name a couple of times, became the 500 Owners Association in 1968.

Drivers such as Stirling Moss and Peter Collins cut their racing teeth driving 500's.

The Championship is divided into three classes based on the age of the cars.

Class P1, 1945 - 1950, Class P2, 1951 - 1953, Class P3, 1954 - 1960,

Today's double-header of two 15-minute races sees 24 cars competing in the Championship.

Overall Championship leader is Alex Wilson in his Cooper MK 10 #99, with Simon Dedman driving the #53 Erskine Staride just 5 points adrift, and Richard Kelly in third place, today driving the unique Heizer #63.

All are likely to be challenging for podium positions, and that illusive sub 1 minute lap time.

Special mention for Jack Bond with his 1953 Martin and Mike Painter with his 1952 Kieft, both racing 500's for the first time, but both experienced racers with other margues.

Vernon Williamson is making the long trek down from his Scottish home to be racing with us once again, although this is topped by Australian driver Kerry Horan with his Trenberth.

Two very distinctive cars to look out for are the shark nosed #19 Cousy driven by JB Jones and the unique bodied Effyh, the Bryfan Tyddyn Special #37 driven by Martin Sheppard.

Mallory is the fourth round of the circuit Championship with two more races to come at The Red Bull Ring in Austria between the 7th and 9th June and finishing the season at Oulton Park for the Gold Cup on 26th to 28th July.

500's have been racing at Mallory since the circuit opened to cars in 1956 and it continues to be a favourite amongst the drivers today, just as it did some 68 years ago.
